

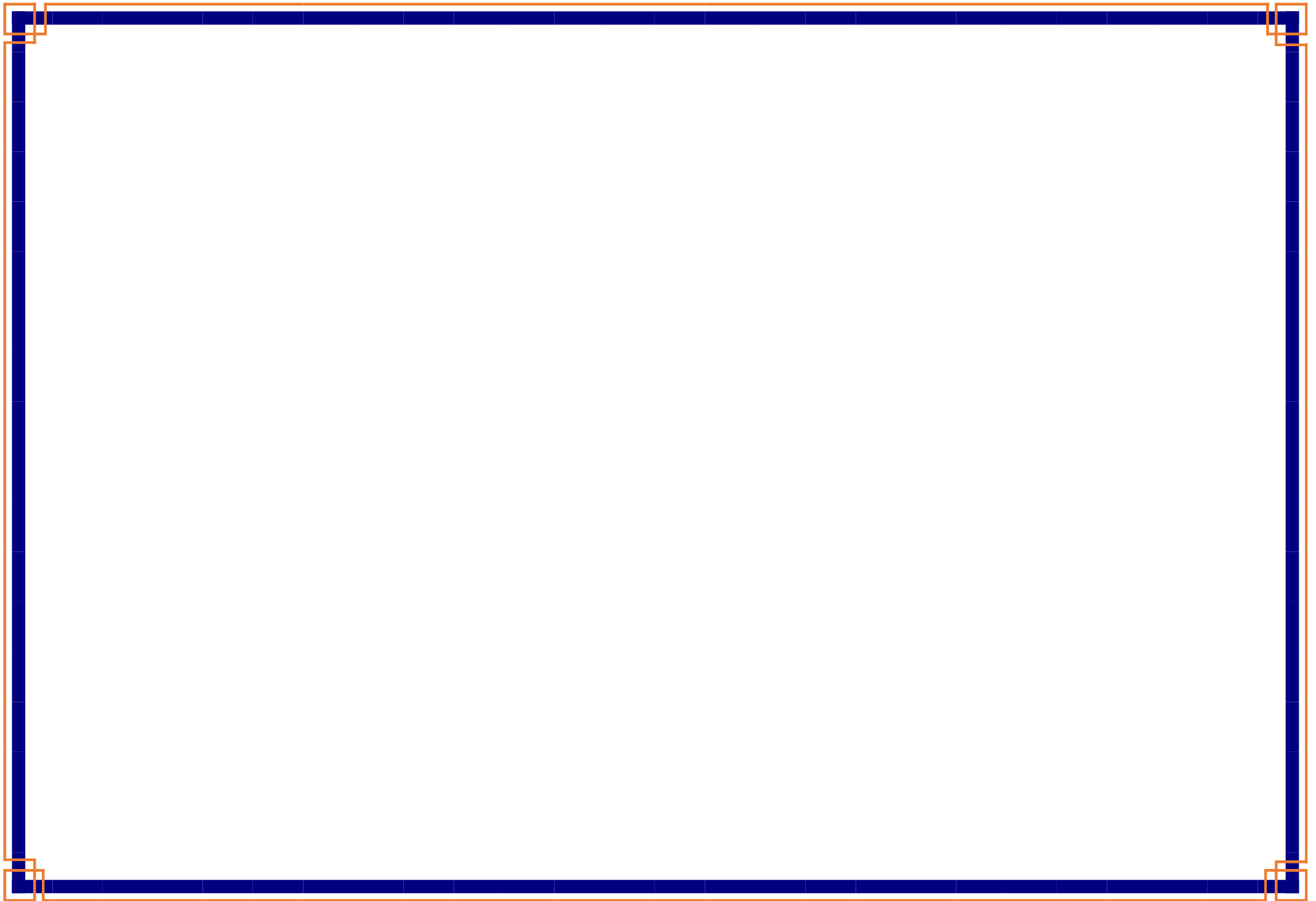
WORDS OF THE WEEK KS3
